

RACK Hamfest POLICY DOCUMENT
2017 Knoxville Hamfest and Electronics Exposition

Inside dealers, exhibitors, outside tailgate participants and others are to follow the following rules and procedures as listed below by The Radio Amateur Club of Knoxville including those stipulated by Kerbela Temple in Knoxville, TN at the site for the event.

1. All inside dealers, exhibitors and outside tailgate participants are fully responsible for collecting and reporting all federal, state and local taxes (as applicable).
2. Smoking is not permitted inside the facility utilized for the hamfest event.
3. The sale of inappropriate items such as knives, guns, explosives, dangerous chemicals, unlicensed software, videotapes, etc., pornographic materials and other items that are inappropriate shall not be exhibited or offered for sale.
4. Packaged items for personal protection (stun guns and pepper spray) shall be allowed subject to following local Knoxville and Tennessee regulations on sale of such items. In addition, these items shall not be sold to persons younger than age 18.
5. Animals are prohibited except for service animals for the disabled or medical alerts.
6. Signage or other items are not to be attached by tape or other damaging means at the facility for advertising or display.
7. Exhibit tables ARE NOT TO BE MOVED or reconfigured except by Hamfest volunteers under the direction of the Radio Amateur Club of Knoxville. Electrical cords must be properly secured in walkways with GAFFERS tape provided by RACK. Limit table loading to 200 lbs. and TABLES SHALL NOT BE SAT ON OR STOOD ON.
8. Neither the Radio Amateur Club of Knoxville nor the Kerbela Temple shall be held responsible for any warranty or the condition of items sold by either the inside dealers, exhibitors or those in the outside tailgate area. Further, neither the Radio Amateur Club of Knoxville nor Kerbela Temple shall be held liable for any injury occurring to participants at the event.
9. Dealers and outside tailgaters shall not leave unsold merchandise, boxes, and other trash upon their departure.
10. Outside tailgate area has a few electrical outlets. Use of the outlets will require a payment of \$25 per user in advance by 4 pm on Friday.
